

- corner on the wrong side of the Orchid and Copper 3 3/1" squares. 1. Using the silver pencil and a ruler, draw a line from corner to (Diagram I)
- together. Sew 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line. ( Diagram II) 2. Lay an Orchid square on top of a Purple Ice square, right sides
- toward the darker fabric. This yields two half-square triangles. (Diagram III) triangles and eight Royal Blue/Copper half-square triangles. Repeat to make a total of eight Purple Ice/Orchid half-square 3. Press to set seam. Cut on the drawn line and press the seams


